

Scholarship Student FAQ's

At Aspire2 International we encourage, celebrate and support academic and professional excellence by awarding a number of scholarships for Diploma students transitioning into their second year.

Here are some frequently asked questions to help you understand the process.....

What is the eligibility criteria for Scholarships?

Your faculty will consider the following criteria when making a scholarship award

- Grade Point Average
- Attendance
- Attitude

How do you measure attitude?

Attitude is made up of many things and your tutors will be considering relevant attributes and behaviour.

These include but are not limited to your participation in class, tutorials and/or practicals, meeting deadlines, improvement shown, collaboration, enthusiasm, perseverance, presentation of self and work, interaction with peers, willingness to assist others, participation in faculty/campus events.

Are there different levels of Scholarships available?

Yes, each Faculty has an allocated Scholarship fund divided into 3 tiers. There is no obligation on the faculty to award all scholarships. In the event of ties the faculty reserves the full discretion to make a final decision on scholarship recipients.

How early can I find out if I have been awarded a scholarship?

Each Faculty will vary but they are always confirmed in the final term of your Year One study. Your HOF will inform you about exact timing directly.

Do I wait until Scholarships have been awarded before I complete a Year2 application form?

No it is important that you complete your Year 2 application form as soon as possible so that we can start the Year 2 process.

Is there an expiry date on Scholarships?

Yes, you must take up your scholarship and transition into Year 2 within 2 terms of your Year 1 finish date.

Can I talk further with someone about scholarships?

Yes, your Head of Faculty or Programme Leader, will be happy to assist.

How do I find out why I have not been awarded a scholarship?

Ask your Head of Faculty or Programme Leader for details.

What if I don't agree with the Scholarship decision?

Faculties will at all times act fairly and with impartiality when making scholarship decisions. If you consider you should have been awarded a scholarship you may request, in writing, a review. Your application should explain why you consider you are eligible for a Year 2 scholarship.
